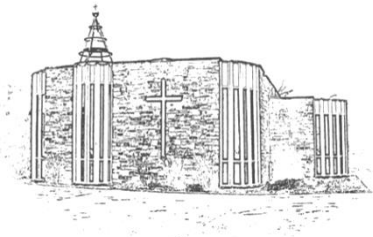
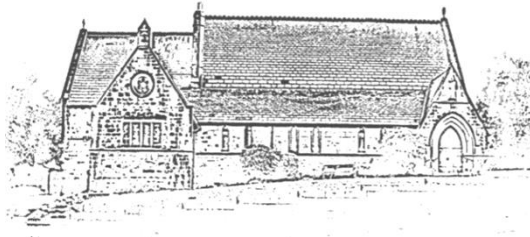




# Parishes of Harden and Wilsden
