Cold Winter Nights are already with us and this coming Monday the first Inn Churches shelter of the winter will begin. This year the parent charity celebrates its 10th birthday with 17 churches opening their doors to the homeless. Our own benefice will once again offer shelter between Christmas and New Year, a special time when most of us have plenty but some have very little.

Steve Rhodes has worked very hard to organise the rota and with just four weeks to go there are just a few crucial gaps. A particular need is for the night shifts. It is especially important that we try to have at least one woman for each night. Juli Thompson, the CEO of Inn Churches, has said we can have a men-only shelter, but emergencies happen and many of us remember setting up a last minute honeymoon suite in St. Matthew's.
