We took two people in for whom this was their first experience of Inn Churches, and one man in particular was in a very sad and difficult situation due to his age and poor health. Inn Churches has now moved on to All Saints in Little Horton. Please continue to pray for them and especially the older man that he may find a suitable home soon. Thank you to everyone who helped in any way, or provided funding, or gave clothes or other items. Thank you also to the Beaver Scouts who made a goody bag for every visitor! Bob
