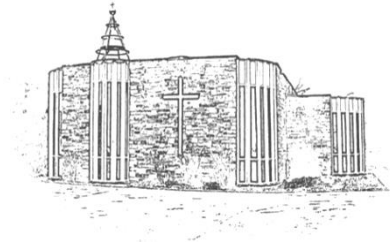
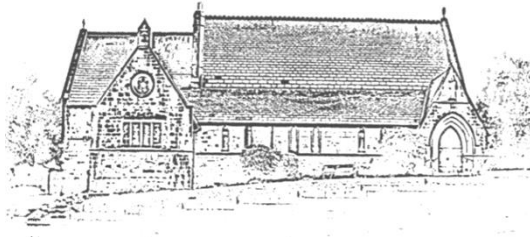


# Parishes of Harden and Wilsden

**A Message from the Inn Churches Charity** In the first full year of our Storehouse project (Bring your tithes to the storehouse, so that everyone may be fed. Malachi 3.10), we intercepted just over 100 tonnes of surplus food that would have otherwise been discarded - worth £168,000 at industry standard retail value (and which would have cost £7,500 to send to landfill). We redistributed it to 30 different community groups, contributing to 238,000 meals, as well as through our pay-as-you-feel café. From our warehouse, we now send out seven weekly pay-as-you-feel mini-markets, taking fresh food to people in seven areas around the city who might not be able to afford it otherwise. We also work with sixteen community organisations who collect food from the warehouse for Bradford-based feeding projects - as well as teaching cooking skills and offering advice, support and signposting to other services as needed. Those fed include people who are homeless, people on low incomes or who are unemployed, young people, parents, asylum seekers, refugees, hard to reach families, people struggling to live independently, and other vulnerable and at risk groups.
