Environment Friendly Advice for March – Going shopping

- 1. Make a list before you go food shopping to help avoid impulse buying and buying food you will end up throwing away.
- 2. Reduce your impact on the environment by buying second hand when you can. Ebay and charity shops are good sources of re-used items.
- 3. When you need to buy a large item research it carefully. Think about how long it could last, how much it costs to run, what it is made of, where it is made, can it be recycled at the end of its life. Better quality items often last longer and so cost you less over time.
- **4.** Tempted to buy on impulse when you are shopping? Get in the habit of coming back the next day or week when you have thought through if you really *need* to buy it.
