Jamie's Ministry of Food closed its central Bradford operation in January after it fell victim to council budget cuts. Over the previous eight years it had taught thousands of people to cook healthy, nutritious meals from scratch using fresh produce from local markets. Fortunately, the project has been rescued by Inn Churches, the Bradford charity which helps those who are homeless or vulnerably housed, and through its Storehouse project, collects, stores and distributes surplus food to people in need. Julie Thompson, the CEO of Inn Churches, said, "Many of the groups and communities we work with have identified food poverty as a key issue and working with the Ministry of Food will enable us to help and support individuals to feed themselves well no matter what their budget – with all the health and social benefits that brings." The Ministry of Food and Inn Churches teams will work together to offer eight-week cooking courses, master classes, school lessons and community events at the Storehouse café in Caledonia Street on the edge of the city centre.
