Sun	31-May	<b>Pentecost.</b> A great mixture of people in Jerusalem said "We hear them telling in our own tongues the mighty works of God." Let us pray this week for Christians throughout the world - partners, mission organisations or our own family or friends far away from us.	
Mon	01-Jun	Pray for the work of CMS, for Awais in Leeds and other mission partners wherever they are.	
Tue	02-Jun	The Leprosy Mission asks us to pray for Chandkiri Hospital in India, in desperate need of funds to provide a sterile environment for eye surgery.	
Wed	03-Jun	Pray for the Children's Society and their work with vulnerable young people, made more difficult at this time.	
Thu	04-Jun	Pray for our Christian partners in Sudan, many facing starvation as opportunities for making a modest living disappear in the lockdown situation.	
Fri	05-Jun	Our Diocese of Leeds has links with churches in Tanzania, originating in links formed by Wakefield Diocese. Like Sudan, Tanzania faces covid-19 with limited medical facilities.
