

Sun	08-Nov	Although we cannot mark Remembrance Sunday in the usual public way, let us use the means available to us to remember those who have died in past wars and to pray for men and women serving in our armed forces now, that they may carry out their duties with courage and honour.
Mon	09-Nov	Pray for Philip Davies our MP, and other members of our national parliament of all parties, for the wisdom and courage to support what is right and good.
