
We pray by listing the things we wish to bring to God and then we end with a short time of silence to offer them to God. It is very simple and everyone is welcome. No great level of holiness is required!!

Yorkshire Water for instance has more than six different support pathways which provide both short and long term financial help to those struggling to keep up with payments.
